Sunday School 9:15 a.m. to 10:10 a.m.

Check in & check-out for all children on Sunday mornings will be in the DPC Kids Check-in area located up the stairs to the right of the main church reception desk. Children in the nursery and toddler rooms will need to fill out a name tag for children's back. Their name tag number matches a number on a smaller tag that parents/guardians will keep and return to childcare workers at pick up.

Nursery and Toddlers class located in the Main Level of Bradley Building

Nursery 3 month-olds to 2-year-olds: Our professional childcare workers will make you and your babies/toddlers feel at home! (Room 160)

Toddlers: Frolic 2-3 year olds (by September 1, 2018): Taught by a team of teachers, your little ones will feel loved and cared for in this class as they hear Bible stories, make crafts, and play. (Room 165)

PreK through 5th grade classes, located on lower level of McGeachy Pre-K and Kindergarten: Godly Play (Blue Room)

Children engage fundamental Bible stories through multi-sensory learning, imagination, and play. It is a theologically sound and developmentally appropriate way for equipping children to articulate their own language of faith.

1st- 5th Grade: Digging Into the Bible in One Year (1st-3rd grade Yellow Room and 4th- 5th grade Green Room)

Children will journey through the Bible and discover people just like them from Genesis to Revelation. They will see evidence of God's love from long ago and learn to look for it in their lives today. Classes will be split up 1st-3rd and 4th-5th. On November 11, there will be a Bible Quiz Show for students in this class. All of the questions will come from the bible stories they learn this fall. The more Sundays that they attend this fall, the greater the chance they will be able to answer more of the questions.

Worship Options 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

Check in for all children on Wednesday Nights will be either on the playground or in the yellow children's ministry room with the childcare workers.

Children are welcome in worship at DPC. Located in the Foyer, there is a "Pack your own worship bag station" with includes children's Bibles, books, bible-based coloring and activity pages. There are also pre-made worship bags are available in the narthex.

Children's Chapel is an interactive worship experience for Pre-K to 2nd grades. Children will engage with worship through activities, games, and crafts as they learn more about what it means to worship God. Children's Chapel is meaningful worship at the same time that it is preparation for worship with the wider congregation.

Children leave for Children's Chapel following the Children's Moment in the Sanctuary. Check out is in the Scott Chapel, located next to the Sanctuary. If this is your first time, don't hesitate to ask someone for help navigating the hallways! You are always welcome to join your child if that helps to make the transition for your child more smooth.

Nursery and Toddlers continue with professional caregivers during the worship hour in Bradley Building rooms 160 and 165. Decatur Presbyterian Church has a staff of professional childcare workers who will make you and your babies/toddlers feel at home.

Children's Choirs:

The objective of the children's choir program is to instill an appreciation for music and singing, to teach responsibility, confidence, independence, and the importance of church involvement, and to usher children into the presence of God. The children's choirs provide music for Sunday worship about once a month and for special services throughout the year.

Safety and Hospitality:

Here at DPC we want to create an environment where your whole family feels safe and loved. One way to accomplish this is through our system of checking in and out our the children.

- Wednesday nights: A book will be on the playground or in the classroom for you
 to sign your child in and out, as well as making a note if they plan to go to choir
 that evening.
- **Sunday mornings**: If you are attending Sunday School, a sign in/out book and greeter will be in the check-in area located outside of the DPCC hallway. Please sign in & out all children who are present for SS as well as those who plan to attend Children's Chapel (PreK-2nd graders).

DPC strives to be a tree nut- and peanut-free campus. Please alert us to any allergies at registration and with check in. We provide a snack of Goldfish for children in 2/3s and Children's Chapel.
